I am a huge basketball fan. The game has been a part of my life since I was a toddler, and I have always held some of the game's stars in the highest of regards: Michael Jordan, Lebron James, Magic Johnson, Larry Bird, etc. In my eyes, there is one player that rises above everyone.

I was saddened Sunday to learn of the passing of NBA great Bill Russell. Russell, who played in the NBA for the Boston Celtics, was the game's greatest winner and ultimate team player. His teams won 11 NBA championships in 13 years, a feat that not even Michael Jordan can claim. Russell was also the first Black head coach of a major American sports team. However, Russell was much more than a phenomenal player and coach. He was a trailblazer, a role model, and a civil rights icon.



Russell stood for something much bigger than the game of basketball. He used his status as an athlete to shed light on and fight against racism in America, and he did so despite the threat of danger to himself and his livelihood as an athlete. Russell never compromised his principles when faced with injustice.

An important part of educating young people is helping them understand the past and how it connects to today. The stories of individuals like Bill Russell are empowering. They show that people can be—and are—powerful actors in shaping the present and the future. I know I will be sharing Russell's story and his accomplishments on and off the court with my daughter in the years to come.

COVID Mask Policy:

For the coming school year, GLA plans to follow Chicago Public Schools' guidance on mask policy. Currently, masks are "highly recommended" for students but not required. Before School Programming:

We are excited to offer **On Deck** before school programming again at GLA this year!

This program will run every day, Monday - Friday, before school from 7:00-7:45 am. Fees will be collected on a monthly basis, due by the first of the month of service. Invoices will be sent via PayPal (no account is needed), and enrollment and un-enrollment will be on a rolling basis.

Please note: Drop-ins are available for a \$10/day flat fee, regardless of the time dropped off.

After School Programming:

We are pleased to offer after school programs that are teacher and student-led. These after school programs will run Monday-Thursday and will vary each trimester, with some new offerings for each grade.

A sign up solely for trimester one will be sent out shortly and is only, Tuesday, September 6th - Thursday, November 10th. All programs will run from 3:15 - 5:00 pm.

You will have the opportunity to sign up your child for programming that will run Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday only. Each program will hold a max capacity for students and you will be notified if you get into the program by **Friday, September 2nd** via letter and email.

The prices for these programs are based on program needs.

*Please note, these programs could overlap with any athletic practices/intersquad games that we offer.

Offerings for trimester one will be sent out shortly via an online form and will be first come, first serve until the program is at max capacity.

Student Records Access:

In accordance with the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act ([FERPA](#)) and the Illinois School Student Records Act ([ISSRA](#)), individuals not verified as the parent or legal guardian must have documentation on file granting them permission to engage in conversation or receive documentation related to student academic performance, attendance, behavior, or any other protected information. If there are members of your family that you would like to grant this level of authorization, please complete the GLA Student Records Release form found [here](#) and return it to our main office. Permission is valid for one calendar year from the date submitted.

Note: Emergency contacts only have the right to receive physical custody of the student. Listing someone as an emergency contact does not give them authorization to access student records.

Note: GLA Staff is not allowed to restrict access to student records for verified parents/guardians, regardless of their personal relationship to the student or primary parent/guardian without valid court documentation on file.

COVID Vaccination Information for Scholars

GLA is currently reviewing our COVID policies for the upcoming school year. Information for the 2022-23 school year will be shared in the coming weeks. In the meantime, we advise all of our families to consider vaccinating their Scholars.

This week and beyond, there are many ways for children to get vaccinated across the city:

- Family health care providers – CDPH recommends families first reach out to their pediatrician or family medical provider to see if appointments are available.
- CPS sites – CPS' regional vaccination clinics and mobile school-based events will offer the Pfizer vaccine for ages 5 to 11 starting on Wednesday, November 10th.

- Local pharmacies – Across the city, many pharmacy locations already have vaccines and more will receive doses in the coming weeks. Each has their own registration.

- Select children's hospitals will host pediatric vaccine events – check hospital websites for dates and more information.

CDPH will host family vaccination clinics at City Colleges of Chicago. These events will offer pediatric COVID-19 Pfizer vaccines, as well as Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson vaccines and booster doses to all Chicagoans. Patients must be 18 or older to receive a J&J vaccine. All clinics will be open 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Registration is required and open now at www.chi.gov/YouthVax.

Starting November 15, CDPH's in-home vaccination program, Protect Chicago At Home, will also offer pediatric vaccination for all children ages 5 to 11. Make an at-home appointment at Chicago.gov/AtHome or by calling (312) 746-4835.

Standing CDPH immunization clinics will also offer pediatric COVID-19 vaccines by appointment only. This includes:

- Greater Lawn WIC located at 4150 W. 55th St. (call 312 745-1477 for an appointment)
