



PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

On Friday, we kicked off Hispanic Heritage Month (September 15th-October 15th) celebrations throughout the school in Morning Meeting classrooms and in Community Celebration. Over the next month, students will learn about the history and influence of Hispanic and Latinx culture on the United States. We want to make sure our students and families with Hispanic and Latinx heritage feel valued and respected, which is how we want students of all cultural heritages to feel.

South Chicago, the neighborhood in which GLA is located, has had a vibrant Latino community for over a century. In the early 1900's, people of Mexican descent began moving to the area to work in the South Works steel foundry owned by the U.S. Steel Corporation. Over the next couple



of decades, the Mexican-American community grew and developed deep social bonds in the area. Their influence in South Chicago was strong and remains strong today. In fact, the very building that houses our gym, cafeteria, and kitchen was not long ago a Catholic church that was home to mostly Mexican-American parishioners, including parents and grandparents of some of our GLA scholars!

Please join the students and staff at GLA in celebrating Hispanic Heritage Month and the rich tapestry of cultures that enrich our school community!

We want to ensure everyone's safety during entry, when dropping of scholars please be sure to follow these safety rules:

- If walking, please do not cross in the middle of the street, be sure to cross on the corner where there is a staff member directing traffic
- If you arrive after 7:55, please use the car line and come into the driveway and come inside to sign your scholars in.
