Parents, we need your help with attendance. Currently, our school wide attendance is around 93%. That is not good enough. At our current rate, that means students are missing an average of more than 1 school day per month. That will add up to 13 absences over the course of the year.

National statistics show that elementary school student attendance impacts a student's ability to read at grade level and is a predictor of high school graduation rates.

Our teachers work hard. We believe that every part of the day matters for a student's academic and social-emotional development. When students are not at school, they are missing out on opportunities to learn and grow.

The GLA Attendance Team will be honoring students who earned perfect attendance in September with a special lunch treat this week. Students with monthly perfect attendance will continue to be honored with incentives and recognition on bulletin boards throughout the school. The team has also been calling parents of students who are missing school regularly and will continue to do so.

Please do your part to make sure that your child is at school on-time every day. Every day and every minute counts!


Bullying
