Through our partnership students will learn music theory, choreography, staging, blocking and participate in a fully costumed professional production. In addition, PTDYA will be launching an after school program for students passionate about the arts called The Academy Kids.

Our main instructors will be Brandon Lampkin, Musical Director, and Michael Jones PTDYA Executive Director who will also be serving as Great Lakes Academy's Artistic Director this school year.
