PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

In the past week, we have seen a significant (but not huge) increase in COVID cases within our student body and our staff. Last year at this time, GLA had a major increase in cases just like the rest of Chicago and the nation. Though the situation this year is much better, we will be operating with caution and will continue monitoring cases very closely. Our actions will be driven by our goals to: 1) keep students, staff, and families safe; 2) to the greatest extent possible, keep students in school for in-person learning.

Like last year, we have access to COVID PCR saliva tests through Illinois SHIELD. Because masks are not required schoolwide this school year, we consider all students in a homeroom where there is a positive case to be close contacts. We test those close contacts on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays to determine if there are additional cases within the classroom. Additionally, students will be required to wear masks in classrooms where a positive student case has been identified (masks are made available in classrooms). When we identify students who test positive for COVID, we notify families to start an isolation period that lasts a minimum of five days.

The school may take additional action that may include, but may not be limited to:

- Enacting a schoolwide testing model on Wednesday.
- Highly recommending schoolwide masking for staff and students.
- Increasing safety protocols that may mitigate the spread of COVID.

Interim Assessments

Over the next two weeks students will be taking the ANET, IA2 and STEP assessment. Here are some tips for testing days:

- Make sure your child gets plenty of rest each night.
- Have a good breakfast or make sure they arrive in enough time to eat breakfast at school. Research shows that children do better on tests if they have had a good breakfast.
- Do as much as you can to make your child feel comfortable. Try not to say things to make him/her feel more nervous.
- Reassure your child that no matter the outcome of the test you will still love him/her. Encourage them to simply do their best.
- When the scores are sent to you, talk to your child's teacher. This will help you to understand them more clearly.
- Give your child praise even if he or she didn't do well on the test.
