# **PRINCIPAL'S CORNER**

GLA Families,

When Dr. Carter G. Woodson forwarded the idea of establishing a week (which later became a month) to promote the study of Black history, he did so because the significant impact of African Americans in history was misrepresented, undertold, or even completely ignored.



Recently, we have seen conflicts raging in society on television, on social media, and in school board meetings over what is taught in schools, particularly involving subjects of race. Among these ideas is that teaching students about the role Black people had in shaping American history does not belong in schools. As a former history teacher, that is unconscionable to me. It is impossible to understand American history without understanding the centrality of the Black experience and its role in shaping America.

We are excited to be celebrating Black History Month at GLA. We have planned a range of events and activities for our students in February in observance. We observe Black History Month to reflect upon and celebrate the achievements and contributions of African Americans throughout history. We observe to help preserve the legacy of Black history. We observe as a school community because it is an important part of our shared cultural heritage.

# AM Drop-Off

We strive to move cars through the morning drop-off line as quickly and<u>safely</u> as possible. We are unable to do that without your help. We want to remind everyone of a couple procedures that will enhance the speed and safety of morning drop-off:

- <u>Do not drop off students in the middle of the street.</u>
- **Do not block crosswalks when waiting in line.** This creates a safety hazard for pedestrians.
- If you park and drop off your student, please make sure they use the crosswalk if they have to cross the street.
- When you are first in the next wave of cars to drop-off, please do not stop at the

84th St. gate or drive school entrance door. Please pull forward a couple of car lengths so more cars can drop off at once.

• Please have your child ready to get out of the car. If they are not ready, pull further forward so cars do not have to wait on you.
