

There will be three different programs offered for students:

- AM Academic Support
- AM and PM Enrichment Camp
- Professional Theater and Dance Youth Academy (PTDYA) Summer Camp

AM Academic Support (8:30am-12:00pm)

This program is **only** for students required to take summer school for promotion. The school's administration will notify families if students are required to take summer school. Doors will open for breakfast at 8am. Lunch will be served at 12pm. The cost is \$150. Students required to take AM Academic Support classes may opt-in for PM Enrichment Camp. The cost for PM Enrichment Camp is an additional \$150.

AM/PM Enrichment Camp (8:30 am - 4:00 pm)

This program is open to all interested K-7th grade students on a first-come, first-served basis. Doors will open for breakfast at 8 am. Lunch will be served at 12 pm. Programming ends at 4 pm. The cost for AM/PM Enrichment Camp is \$300.

PTDYA Summer Camp (8:30 am - 4:00 pm)

This program is open to 4th-7th graders who are interested in music and theater. Participants will be rehearsing for an end of program performance that will take place on July 21st at GLA. Doors will open for breakfast at 8 am. Lunch will be served at 12 pm. The cost for PTDYA Summer Camp is \$400.
